



## NOTES ON THE MASS OCT 24 2021

### SPIRITUALITY OF THE READING

#### What Do You Want?

In the [Gospel Reading](#) blind Bartimaeus will not stop yelling for Jesus to have pity on him, until Jesus finally calls for him.

At this point the funny parts of the story start. Why doesn't Jesus go over to Bartimaeus? Why wait for the blind man to find his way to Jesus? And when Bartimaeus does find his way to him, Jesus asks him what seems like the dumbest question: "What do you want me to do for you?" What on earth would anybody suppose Bartimaeus wants? He's blind!

And when Jesus heals him and Bartimaeus can see, Jesus says that Bartimaeus's faith has saved him. But why? What does Bartimaeus's receiving his sight have to do his being saved?

Here we need to notice what Bartimaeus actually says to Jesus in answer to Jesus' question to him. Bartimaeus does not say to Jesus, "I want my sight." He says, "I want to see." To want sight is to want a capacity which can be used for all kinds of purposes—raising sheep, making money. But to want to see is to want the connection with reality that the exercise of sight makes possible. **Wanting to see is wanting to know the true nature of reality, hidden in one way from a person when he is blind.**

Once we see what Bartimaeus asks for, the funny parts of the story make more sense. When Jesus calls Bartimaeus to himself, he gives Bartimaeus a small period of time to consider what he *really* wants before Jesus asks him. Then the presence of the Lord and that question serve as a call to Bartimaeus to commit himself to just one heart's-desire—and Bartimaeus finds it: I want to *see*.

Seeing isn't limited to seeing the blue of the sky or the road to home. It is also a matter of seeing the truth about things, or even of seeing the Truth himself.

So Jesus gives Bartimaeus all that he asks for. Bartimaeus sees not only the world around him but also his Lord. And in seeing Jesus, Bartimaeus accepts the Giver together with the gift of sight. Although Jesus gives Bartimaeus the option of going away, Bartimaeus stays by Jesus and follows him.

Bartimaeus came to Jesus and he saw the Lord, because seeing was what he really wanted. And that's why Jesus tells him that his faith has saved him.

## BRING THE GOSPEL HOME OCT 24 2021

READING I Jeremiah 31:7-9

PSALM 126:1-6

READING II Hebrews 5:1-6

GOSPEL Mark 10:46-52

**Question for Children:** What would you like to ask Jesus for?

**Question for Youth:** "Master, I want to see!" What do you most want to be able to "see" in your own life? How are you blind?

**Question for Adults:** What does it mean for you to "see"? Are there blind spots in your life?

Use these activities as a way to further reflect on the Sunday readings:

- Think about your family. Decide how the Lord has brought strength out of a weakness in your family. Does someone in your family need special help? How has this helped to bring out the best in your family?
- Review with your family the Corporal Works of Mercy. Have them select one or two of these to carry out this week: Feed the hungry - Give drink to the thirsty - Clothe the naked - Visit the imprisoned - Shelter the homeless - Visit the sick - Bury the dead.



SAINT OF THE WEEK

### **Blessed Teresa of Calcutta, Religious**

Agnes Gonxha Bojaxhiu was born in Skopje, Macedonia, on August 27, 1910. As a young girl, Agnes developed the desire to serve God as a missionary. The desire was strengthened at age twelve when a Jesuit missionary visited her classroom and spoke of his ministry to the people of India. Eventually she worked among the poor and dying of India's slums, bringing them love and hope in the Gospel. A group of religious women joined her in this ministry, the Missionaries of Charity, initially about dozen sisters, all former students of Mother Teresa joining her in her ministry to the "poorest of the poor."

During Mother Teresa's lifetime, the Missionaries of Charity grew in number to many thousands and were joined by the Missionary Brothers of Charity, an order for men established by her when several men wished to be part of her ministry.

**Mother Teresa's message today:** "We will be judged according to how we have treated the hungry, the sick, the marginated. We will be judged on the love we have shown them...We should...treat them as we would treat Jesus himself."

*How have you shown your love for the poor? Do you, as Mother Teresa did, see Jesus in every face?*
