






## FROM THE CHURCH FEB 6 2022

FOOD PANTRY The Des Moines Area Religious Council (DMARC) has provided a food pantry service to the Des Moines area for the past 45 years. It now provides food security to families from 14 partner food pantries and 31 mobile food pantry sites located throughout the city. During this time of Pandemic, more people are being assisted now than at any time in the program's history. We are still accepting donations here at HT. Those wishing to provide their support may drop either food or non-food items (diapers, wipes, personal products, etc.) into one of the green collection tubs located at the Holy Trinity Church entries. DMARC also welcomes cash/check donations as they are able to buy items at discounted prices and realize savings with their purchases. Checks written should be made payable to Holy Trinity (noted for DMARC) and placed in the collection basket. Thank you for your continued support.



FAMILY PROMISE VOLUNTEERS NEEDED Family Promise Greater Des Moines (FPGD) provides shelter to homeless families with the help of area religious institutions. Holy Trinity is scheduled to assist FPGD with hosting duties January 30 through February 6. The organization is asking people to help that week as either a meal volunteer or overnight volunteer. These volunteer opportunities all take place at the gathering house at Faith Lutheran Church located at 10395 University Ave in Clive. The gathering house is the duplex with the large ramp just off the church's north parking lot. Meal volunteers deliver food to the gathering house entrance between 5:15-5:30 PM each day. This is a "no contact" delivery as food is left in a cart placed by FPGD staff outside entrance. Overnight duties are simple and limited. Social distancing with our guests is strictly enforced to ensure limited exposure. Your primary job is to sleep on beds provided at the gathering house. # Putting Faith to Work

We are partnering with Iowa Vocational Rehabilitation Services, Supported Employment Organizations Candeo, Easterseals of Iowa, Link and the Diocese of Des Moines to build a referral network to connect businesses with this potential workforce.





Dear Friends in Christ,

Over the past year, the pastors in the Des Moines area have been working together to address a specific recommendation of the strategic plan commissioned before I became your bishop to form a PreK-12 regional system for the Catholic schools in the greater Des Moines area.

Creating a regional system will help enhance the excellence that already exists by addressing issues identified in the plan: inequities in teacher compensation and the ability to attract and maintain quality teachers; the lack of sufficient tuition assistance; administrator and pastor time spent in areas that take them away from their main focus as faith and education leaders; duplication of business operations across all parish schools; and the complexity and costs related to parishes operating and supporting schools individually.

Since January 2021, area pastors have met biweekly to research and more fully comprehend the regionalization concept. I have attended periodic meetings and remained informed of their progress. There have also been meetings with administrators and boards of education to share information and gather feedback.

The pastors have recommended to me that the Catholic schools in the Des Moines area be formed into a PreK-12 regional system. I have reviewed their work and after prayerful consideration and consultation, I endorse their recommendation.

I am convinced that continuing to operate under the current system will eventually curtail our schools' pursuit of excellence. In contrast, regional alignment will increase tuition assistance and teacher compensation, maximize efficiency and use of resources, focus pastor and administrator work, and enhance parish vitality. We can be better by working together. Regionalization of the 12 Catholic schools in the Des Moines area will help position us for a successful and sustainable future. I am grateful for the ongoing work of our pastors, boards, administrators and volunteers who bear the extensive expertise that will propel the regionalization process forward. In the months ahead, we will establish a legal and canonical entity, develop bylaws, and select a board and leadership. This process will take time and effort over the coming years and we look forward to sharing updates on our progress.

We have been entrusted with a share of God's Kingdom mission where we assist parents by providing an education where our young people flourish and come to maturity in Christ. I ask that you keep our school communities and those working on this initiative in your prayers.

#### SPIRITUALITY OF THE READING

#### To Raise the World

The <u>First Reading</u> is about the call of Isaiah: "Whom shall I send?" The next two readings are about the apostles, those who were sent by Jesus to carry his message and carry on his work.

Who are Jesus' apostles in our world? Whom will God send today?

When God wants to send a message of love to the outcasts of this world who will say "Here I am; send me!"

When God wants someone to speak out in the halls of government on behalf of the voiceless who will say "Here I am; send me!"

When all the world marches out to war and God needs someone to march in the opposite direction, a messenger of peace who will say "Here I am; send me!"

As the world suffers from the ill effects of the injustice it has caused, and the Church offers a way out through its social teaching, where are the Catholics who will bring that message to the world? Who will say "Here I am; send me!"


The Christian calling has to do with what is known in Catholic social thought as the common good. "Watch over your family and keep us safe in your care." Question for Children: What is a way that you can


follow Jesus?

#### SAINT OF THE WEEK

#### **Apollonia, Virgin and Martyr**

Apollonia was martyred in Alexandria in the last year of the reign of Emperor Philip. A mob was killing Christians for not blaspheming God and worshiping false gods. The pagans beat her and knocked out all of her teeth. They dragged her out of the city, lit a great fire, and threatened to throw her into it unless she blasphemed God. She asked for a moment's delay, they released her, and she threw herself into the fire. Apollonia, a deaconess, is the patron saint of dentists. She is honored by dentists and invoked against toothache and all dental diseases.

**Apollonia's message today:** Standing up for one's faith is easy only if that faith is strong. Faith will remain strong only if we ask God to give us the strength we need to face the many obstacles and temptations which cross our paths.

When times of trial occur in your life, do you turn first to God for help?
