

Notes on the Mass | January 21st, 2024

Third Sunday of Ordinary Time

Ordinary Time- For a large part of the liturgical year, we devote ourselves to listening to the mystery of Christ in all its aspects unfolded as we seek God's truth and understanding.

Reading I: Jonah 3:1-5, 10

They believed in God and proclaimed a fast.

- The story told in the Book of Jonah illustrates the power of God's mercy and the possibility of conversion for all people.
- Jonah had trouble believing that God wanted him to preach to the people of Nineveh because they were Gentiles.
- After Jonah is rescued from the belly of a great fish, he preaches God's message of repentance to the people of Nineveh and they respond fully.

Reading II: 1 Corinthians 7:29-31

The time is short.

- Early in his ministry, Paul expected the second coming of Jesus at any moment.
- Paul points out in today's reading that happiness and security can not be found in material things.
- All other things are subordinate to life in Jesus.

Gospel: Mark 1:14-20

Come, follow me.

- Mark's Gospel reveals Jesus to be the fulfillment of the promised Messiah.
- Jesus is the Good News.
- In today's passage, the first disciples respond immediately to Jesus call to have faith in the good news.



Bring Home the Gospel | January 21st, 2024

Reading I: Jonah 3: 1-5, 10 | Psalm 25: 4-5,6-7, 8-9 | Reading II: 1 Corinthians 7:29-31 | Gospel: Mark 1: 14-20

Question for Children: What do you think it was like for the people in today's Gospel to be called by Jesus? What did they have to give up in order to follow him?

Question for Youth: At the start of Jesus' ministry, Jesus invites people to "believe in the Good News." What are some ways that you could be more open to the truth and challenge contained within the Gospels?

Activity of the Week: As a family, make a list of ways each individual's life and your family life is influenced by your faith in Jesus. After brainstorming the list, talk about a few of the items. Finally, decide on one thing your family will do this week to put into practice the faith you share.



Saint Of The Week: Thomas Aquinas, Priest and Doctor

Saint's message today: Thomas was the son of a count and a relative of both the Emperor of the Holy Roman Empire and the King of France. He joined the Dominicans and was ordained a priest about 1250. Thomas became a master of theology. He then moved on to teaching and writing, first in Paris and then in other schools. His greatest opus, the *Summa Theologica*, a work that deals with Catholic theology in its entirety, remains a staple for all theological studies. Thomas Aquinas is considered the preeminent

spokesman for the Catholic tradition of reason and of divine revelation. His writings are required study for all theological students even to this day. He was canonized a saint in 1323 and declared a Doctor of the Church by Pope Pius V in 1567.
