

Notes on the Mass | November 19, 2023

Thirty-third Sunday in Ordinary Time

Ordinary Time

For a large part of the liturgical year, we devote ourselves to listening to the mystery of Christ in all its aspects unfolded as we seek God's truth and understanding.

Reading I: Proverbs 31:10-13, 19-20, 30-31 | The wise woman receives her reward.

- The poem of the first reading is the conclusion of the Book of Proverbs.
- It is very likely that the poem is about both a good wife and Wisdom herself.
- The poem highlights the point that whoever finds Wisdom does indeed find life.

Reading II: 1 Thessalonians 5:1-6 | You are children of the light.

- The Thessalonians were caught between worry over the imminent return of Christ and the complacency in their faith.
- Paul instructed them to be diligent in preparing, but not to worry.
- Christians are children of light.

Gospel: Matthew 25:14-30 | We must use the gifts we have been given!

- The Gospel reading deals with the end of the world and the coming of God's Kingdom.
- The paradox of today's parable is that the one who played it safe lost while, in the end, the risk-takers gained.
- Faithfulness implies not only keeping the tradition but also the willingness to risk everything in order to increase God's Kingdom.

Reading I Proverbs 31:10-13, 19-20, 30-31 | **Psalm** 128:1-5 | **Reading II** 1 Thessalonians 5:1-6 | **Gospel** Matthew 25:14-30

Question For The Children Name one talent or gift that God has given you and tell how you have used it.

Question For The Youth Name three talents that you have. How can you use these talents in the next week to make someone's life better?

Question For The Adults Using Jesus' parable as your starting point, describe in your own words how you are using your own gifts to enrich the reign of God.

Activity Of The Week Explore the service opportunities available in your community. Discuss with your family ways that you can use your gifts to make life better for someone less fortunate.



Saint Of The Week Cecilia

Much of the knowledge about Cecilia is based on Tradition. Cecilia was born in Rome, the daughter of patrician parents, and was raised as a Christian. When of a suitable age, she was married against her will to Valerian. After their marriage, she converted Valerian and his brother, Tiburtius, to Christianity. Valerian and Tiburtius devoted themselves to good works until they were arrested by the Roman prefect, Almachius. They were martyred, together with Maximus, a Roman official, who had been so impressed by their witness to Christ that he too became a Christian. These three martyrs are also saints. Cecilia buried the three and was, in turn, arrested and called upon to renounce her faith. Instead she converted her persecutors. She was ultimately martyred for her faith and we honor her for that today.

Cecilia's message today:

Only a very strong faith could withstand the pressures and threats that faced Cecilia and the martyrs of her time. Instead of caving in to those pressures, Cecilia, her husband, and brother-in-law brought more converts into the Church. By word and by example, we too can both strengthen our faith and bring others to Christ. Are you living your life to draw others to Jesus?


