Notes on the Mass | February 26th, 2025

Seventh Sunday of Ordinary Time

Ordinary Time- For a large part of the liturgical year, we devote ourselves to listening to the mystery of Christ in all its aspects unfolded as we seek God's truth and understanding.

Reading I: 1 Samuel 26:2, 7-9, 12-13, 22-23

Though the Lord delivered you into my grasp, I would not harm you.

- Consumed with jealousy, Saul and three thousand men head into the desert searching for David.
- When given the opportunity, David does not harm Saul because he is God's anointed.
- The Lord will reward the just and faithful.

Reading II: 1 Corinthians 15:45-49

Just as we have borne the image of the earthly one, we shall also bear the image of the heavenly one.

- As humans, we resemble Adam, who was made from the earth. We also inherit Adam's weaknesses.
- We are also created in God's image.
- We will share in Jesus' Resurrection.

Gospel : Luke 6:27-38

Be merciful, just as your Father is merciful.

- Jesus teaches the disciples to love their enemies.
- Treat others as you want to be treated.
- Be kind to the ungrateful and wicked.



Bring Home the Gospel | February 26th, 2025

Reading I 1 Samuel 26:2, 7-9, 12-13, 22-23 | Psalm | Reading II 1 Corinthians 15:45-49 | Gospel Luke 6:27-38

Question For The Children Jesus tells us to treat others as we would want others to treat us. How do you treat others as you want to be treated?

Question For The Youth How do you follow Jesus' teaching to "bless those who curse you, pray for those who mistreat you?

Question For The Adults Jesus says, "Give, and gifts will be given to you." When have you experienced your generosity coming back to you?

Activity Of The Week Jesus teaches that if we "give, gifts will be given" to us. Invite each family member to share about a time when they were generous or did an act of service and they received gifts in return.

Fasting during Lent. Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting for Catholics age 18 to 59. A person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are no equal to a full meal. All Fridays are days of abstinence (no meat) for all Catholics age 14 and older.

Saint Of The Week Vincent de Paul, Priest Vincent was born at Pouy, France in 1581, the third of six children. He was ordained a priest and served in several key positions. He became noted for his work among the poor, and was a chaplain to galley slaves waiting to be shipped abroad. In 1625, with the help of a wealthy friend, Vincent founded the Congregation of the Missions (known today as the Vincentians), an order devoted to work among the peasants.

In 1633, along with Saint Louise de Marillac, he founded the Sisters of Charity. In his lifetime, Vincent de Paul established hospitals, orphanages, and seminaries; ransomed slaves in northern Africa; sent his priests abroad to preach missions; and organized far-flung relief among victims of war. It is remarkable that one man could achieve so much.

Even though he was ordained a priest at an early age, it took an awakening event for Vincent to recognize what God was calling him to do. The same is true for many of us, no matter what age we are. God may be asking us to do something as simple as praying for our neighbor. On the other hand, God may be asking us to do much more.
