Palm Sunday of the Passion of the Lord

Palm Sunday of the Lord's Passion

Reading I: Isaiah 50:4-7

He opens my ear that I may hear.

- The first reading from Isaiah is taken from the third "Song of the Suffering Servant."
- It shows us the disciple whose faithfulness is based on fidelity to God.
- Although the passage was originally written about someone else, when we read this passage we immediately think of Jesus.

Reading II: Philippians 2:6-11

He emptied himself, taking the form of a slave.

- The second reading from Paul's Letter to the Philippians is a quotation from an early Christian hymn that proclaims the meaning of Jesus' death and resurrection.
- Even though Jesus was God, he obediently accepted the humiliation of the cross, and God raised him in glory.
- Paul's challenge is to make Jesus' attitude our own.

Gospel: Mark 14:1-15:47

The passion of our Lord Jesus Christ.

- The Passion story from the Gospel according to Mark shows Jesus to us as the suffering servant portrayed in the prophecy of Isaiah.
- Mark places Jesus' suffering and death in the context of the Passover meal which draws on Jewish theology.
- In Mark's account of the Passion, Jesus is alone with no one to comfort him as he approaches the ultimate sacrifice.



Bring Home the Gospel | March 24th, 2024


Reading I Isaiah 50:4-7 | Psalm 22 | Reading II Philippians 2:6-11 | Gospel Mark 14:1-15:47

Question For The Children Name one thing that you will do each day this week to remind you that Jesus died and rose to new life for you.

Question For The Youth We hear the story of Jesus' death each year. What did you hear differently this year? How has your faith changed in the past year?

Question For The Adults Identify and share one way that you personally "die in Christ."

Activity Of The Week Together with your family discuss the Lord's Passion and its meaning for us. Invite family members to share what part of the Passion story touches them most.



Saint Of The Week Vincent Ferrer, Priest,
1350-1419 Vincent was said to have the gift of
tongues. While he spoke only Spanish, plus some
Latin for the Mass and a few words of Hebrew,
everyone who heard him on his journey heard
him in their own language. Many miracles were
performed by Vincent, including raising a man,
who had been murdered, from the dead. In some
of the places where he preached, the number of
sick children was such that he set aside some time
each afternoon to tend to these. In all, Vincent
converted many thousands of heretics, Jews, and
Muslims during his lifetime, as well as bringing
untold numbers of lapsed Catholic back to the
Church.

St. Vincent Ferrer is the patron saint of builders, construction workers, brick makers, tile makers, road builders, and plumbers. He is honored by an optional memorial on April 5.

Saint's message today: Few of us will have visions of Christ calling us to ministry, but all of us are called by God for a purpose in life.
