

HOLY TRINITY PATCH | PROGRAM UPDATE | April 2024


Since 1986, Holy Trinity's Parish Assisted Temporary Care and Housing (PATCH) project has provided housing for a family transitioning from a homeless shelter. In addition to co-signing a lease on the apartment, we help pay utilities as the family gets back on their feet. Typically, families moving from the shelter have very few possessions, so when a new family enters the PATCH program, we will request donations of gently used furniture, housewares and clothing to help get the family settled. It is truly inspiring to witness that whenever we have a need arise for a homeless family, that Holy Trinity is able to provide.

The mom, dad and teenage son that was living in PATCH since September have now taken over the lease on the apartment. The mom and teen have found jobs. Dad is dealing with some health issues and hoping to get disability assistance soon. We supported them for an additional month to help ensure they were a bit more stable. They expressed their gratitude for all the

support that was provided to them over the past 7 months.

In order to continue our mission of helping families transitioning from homelessness, we are needing parishioner support.

We rely on donations to cover the monthly expenses of the PATCH apartment. While the family is in the program, typically for 6-12 months, Holy Trinity pays their monthly rent and utilities. The expenses are about \$1,000 per month. We currently have about \$3,000 in our PATCH account and would like to have at least \$12,000 (or one year of assistance) before we commit to assisting another family.



We are very grateful to a number of people who help support PATCH throughout the year with monetary donations by using the blue tithing envelopes or online at holytrinitydm.org/donate.

Notes on the Mass | April 14th, 2024

Third Sunday of Easter

Easter- The sound of Alleluias fills the 50 days of Easter Sunday to Pentecost as we give thanks for the gift of our salvation. The Easter Triduum recalls the passion and resurrection of Christ in the sacred journey from Holy Thursday to Easter Vigil. "Dying he destroyed our death. Rising he restored our life."

Reading I: Acts 3:13-15, 17-19

God raised Christ from the dead.

- In the reading from the Acts of the Apostles, Peter explains that Jesus is the fulfillment of the ancient messianic promises.
- Jesus, the Messiah, who died and was raised to new life, brought a new life of peace and right relationship with God.
- Through Jesus, God's merciful love is available to all those who seek it.

Reading II: 1 John 2:1-5

Whoever keeps God's word has love made perfect.

- The first part of the second reading reminds believers that sin still exists in the world.
- Believers must walk in light because God is light.
- Christ, who lives in a totally loving relationship with the Father, is also the Advocate who pleads our cause with the Father.

Gospel : Luke 24:35-48

He stood in their midst.

- The author of today's Gospel attempts to tell us that Jesus' resurrection involves the whole person, body and spirit.
- After his resurrection, when Jesus eats with the disciples, they recognize him in the breaking of bread.
- Life in Christ is a life of forgiveness and peace.



Bring Home the Gospel | April 14th, 2024

Reading | Acts 3:13-15, 17-19 | Psalm 33 | Reading | 1 John 2:1-5 | Gospel Luke 24:35-48

Question For The Children Name some times when you know Jesus is with you.

Question For The Youth What are some ways that you know that God is with you? Who are the people, where are the place, and what are the occasions when you feel closest to God?

Question For The Adults When have you had an "Aha" moment, when you suddenly realized that God was with you?

Activity Of The Week Ask each member of the family how they can be a light in a world of darkness. Can light conquer darkness? Can darkness conquer light? Think of a flashlight in a dark place: Can the darkness prevail over the light of the flashlight?

Saint Of The Week Louis de Montfort, Priest, 1673-1716

Born Louis-Marie Grignion on January 31, 1673 in Montfort, France, this saint was the oldest surviving child of a large family. Even as a young child, Louis exhibited a remarkable spiritual maturity.

At the age of twelve, he was sent to the Jesuit College of St. Thomas Becket in Rennes where he developed a strong devotion to the Blessed Virgin Mary. Awareness of the needs of the poor and the sick also developed during his years at St. Thomas. Together with some of his classmates, Louis spent some holidays tending to the needs of the poor and nursing the sick in hospitals.

Fr. Louis had a strong positive influence on the people to whom he preached, but, as might be expected, this made him many enemies, among them the Jansenists. The schismatic teachings of Jansen had quite an extensive following around this time in history. Jansenists believed that man was inherently evil and predestined for hell without the strong intervention of God. Minor acts, such as fleeting thoughts, were sinful. Only by frequent confession, at least daily, if possible, and always confessing immediately before receiving Eucharist, could salvation be accomplished.



Despite his conflicts with the Jansenists, Louis de Montfort was also an inspired writer. He wrote several books encouraging devotion to Mary. Several of these are available today and one, *The Secret of the Rosary*, is still the most influential work on the rosary.

Fr. Louis de Montfort died on April 28, 1716, at Saint-Laurent-sur-Sèvre in the Vendee department of France. A measure of his lasting influence was the strong resistance of the people of this region to the anti-clerical revolution, which took place three quarters of a century after his death.

St. Louis de Montfort is the patron saint of preachers. An optional memorial on April 28 honors him.

Saint's message today: All of us meet obstacles in life's journey. St. Louis overcame those that he encountered by frequent prayer and devotion to Mary.
