

#### Notes on the Mass | April 27th, 2025

#### Second Sunday of Easter

**Easter** The sound of Alleluias fills the 50 days of Easter Sunday to Pentecost as we give thanks for the gift of our salvation. The Easter Triduum recalls the passion and resurrection of Christ in the sacred journey from Holy Thursday to Easter Vigil. "Dying he destroyed our death. Rising he restored our life."

#### Reading I: Acts 5:12-16

The number of women and men who came to believe increased steadily.

- The first reading from Acts of the Apostles summarizes the ideal Christian community.
- Today's passage describes the witness of the community to outsiders.
- The Christian community continues the healing ministry of the Risen Christ.

#### Reading II: Revelation 1:9-11a, 12-13, 17-19

I was dead and now I am to live for ever and ever.

- Today's reading from Revelation recounts the first vision of the book.
- The author describes a vision of the victorious Christ holding all power, even over death.
- Christ is the beginning and the end, his power endures beyond all persecution.

#### Gospel : John 20:19-31

After eight days Jesus came in and stood among them.

- The Gospel passage narrates two appearances of the risen Jesus. In both stories, his first words are "Peace be with you."
- Jesus sent his disciples out with the gift of peace, to be signs of his healing presence in the world.
- The second appearance involves the apostle Thomas who needs evidence of Jesus' resurrection.



#### Bring Home the Gospel | April 27th, 2025

#### Reading I | Psalm | Reading II | Gospel

**Question For The Children** Jesus appeared to the disciples even though they were afraid and locked in the closed room. How can you show Jesus to another person this week by how you act?

**Question For The Youth** Thomas didn't believe because he hadn't seen Jesus with his own eyes. How hard is it for you to believe in God without being able to see God? How do you see God in the words and actions of others?

**Question For The Adults** Jesus said: "Blessed are those who have not seen and yet believe." Give one example of how you will show your belief in Jesus this week - how you are being sent forth.

**Activity Of The Week** Talk about people who put their faith in Jesus into action in the world. Explain to your family that a person may be criticized and put down for doing good. Make a family effort this week to recognize the good actions of members of the family. Support and praise each other instead of putting each other down.

#### Saint Of The Week Stanislaus, Bishop and Martyr

Stanislaus was the only child of a noble family from Poland, and an answer to his parents' prayers. They dedicated his life to God. He was ordained as archdeacon and preacher and brought reformation of morals to the people of Cracow. Stanislaus, now a bishop, excommunicated the brutal ruler of Poland for abducting a nobleman's wife. When Boleslaus II's troops would not kill Stanislaus during a Mass, he went into the chapel and murdered Stanislaus himself. Saint Stanislaus is the patron saint of Cracow.

One tradition is that Boleslaus, finally remorseful, left Poland and spent the rest of his life in repentance in a monastery. Butler tells us that while there was no immediate popular uprising, this murder hastened Boleslaus' fall from power.

St. Stanislaus is the patron of Cracow. A memorial celebrates this saint's life on April 11.

**Stanislaus' message today:** This saint finds himself in the good company of saints like John the Baptist, Thomas Becket and Thomas More. Like them, he opposed the tyranny of a despot and, like them, he paid with his life. We often hear a great hue and cry about the separation of church and state and, usually, this is a good thing. There are times, however, when the church must take a stand for what is right in the same way that Stanislaus did.




