DES MOINES REGIONAL CATHOLIC SCHOOLS

All Iowa residents are eligible for an ESA in the 2025-2026 school year.

Application window opens April 16 and closes June 30, 2025. For the 2025-26 school year, the amount will be \$7,826 or more. Applications are required to be completed annually to verify student eligibility through confirmation of lowa residency. Funds must be used for tuition, fees, and other eligible qualified education expenses at an accredited, nonpublic school in lowa. Unused funds remain in the family's account and may be used for future expenses.

Notes on the Mass | May 11th, 2025

Fourth Sunday of Easter

Easter- The sound of Alleluias fills the 50 days of Easter Sunday to Pentecost as we give thanks for the gift of our salvation. The Easter Triduum recalls the passion and resurrection of Christ in the sacred journey from Holy Thursday to Easter Vigil. "Dying he destroyed our death. Rising he restored our life."

Reading I: Acts 13:14, 43-52

Many became believers.

- The reading from Acts describes the first missionary outreach of the early church.
- Paul and Barnabas were sent forth by the Holy Spirit to spread the good news.
- When they were rejected by the Jews, Paul and Barnabas decided to bring the message to the Gentiles.

Reading II: Revelation 7:9, 14b-17

The Lamb at the throne will be their shepherd and will lead them to springs of living water.

- Today's passage from Revelation was part of a grand vision in which all God's faithful were gathered.
- The faithful "survived the time of great distress", which probably refers to persecution of the early church.
- God's faithful became united with Christ in his death and were sustained in life by him.

Gospel: John 10:27-30

I give my sheep eternal life.

- In the Gospel, Jesus describes himself as the Good Shepherd.
- The passage goes on to describe the relationship between Jesus and his Father.
- John stresses the unity between Jesus and the Father.



Bring Home the Gospel | May 11th, 2025

Reading I Acts 13:14, 43-52
| Psalm | Reading II Revelation 7:9, 14b-17 | Gospel John 10:27-30

Question For The Children Jesus promises to guard us like a shepherd does the sheep. How do you experience his loving care in your life?

Question For The Youth Jesus said "My sheep hear my voice; I know them, and they follow me." How does Jesus speak to you? What new path is he asking of you?

Question For The Adults What is your experience of being a follower of Christ, of being cared for and guarded with him as shepherd?

Activity Of The Week Jesus said, "My sheep hear my voice. I know them, and they follow me." Where do you think Jesus is leading your family?

Saint Of The Week St. Anselm of Canterbury, Bishop and Doctor, 1033-1109 Anselm was born in Italy and acquired a love of learning from his mother. He knew at an early age that he wanted to become a monk, and did so in 1060. He preferred the contemplative life, but after serving fifteen years as Prior, Anselm was chosen as Abbot of Bec in 1078. He composed many theological and philosophical writings during this time. He gained a reputation as a holy and scholarly man. William the Conqueror, on his deathbed, sought consolation from Anselm. Anselm eventually served as Archbishop of Canterbury the last sixteen years of his life.

Anselm's knowledge, passed on in his writings, has been favorably compared to that of Sts. Augustine and Thomas Aquinas and he was considered the foremost theologian of his time. He was canonized in 1494 by Pope Alexander VI. He is honored by an optional memorial on the anniversary of his death, April 21.

Anselm's message today: Thrust into positions which he did not seek and tried to decline, Anselm nevertheless served well and earned the respect of all but a few of his flock.

• How do you approach those unwelcome assignments into which you have been thrust? Do you put your best effort into them? Ask St. Anselm to help you.
