The Des Moines Area Religious Council (DMARC) Food Pantry Network continues to serve a growing number of people each year. This past year has seen the number of individuals assisted to be the highest on record with as many as 1 in 3 of those utilizing DMARC for the first time. Those individuals and families often have jobs and homes but didn't earn enough to pay other expenses and buy food weekly. Many turn to DMARC for support.

DMARC welcomes food and non-food items like diapers (large sizes), formulas, baby food, baby wipes, personal products, etc. Items may be placed in one of the collection tubs in the collection location at the side entrance of the church. DMARC also welcomes cash donations as they are able to buy items at discounted prices. Cash donations may be made by using the **QR code** system now in place through the Church Office or by email, <u>holytrinitydm.org/donate</u>

Pentecost

Easter: The sound of Alleluias fills the 50 days of Easter Sunday to Pentecost as we give thanks for the gift of our salvation. The Easter Triduum recalls the passion and resurrection of Christ in the sacred journey from Holy Thursday to Easter Vigil. "Dying he destroyed our death. Rising he restored our life."

Reading I : Acts 2:1-11

All were filled with the Holy Spirit.

- In the Acts of the Apostles, the story of Pentecost occurs on the fiftieth day after Passover, the day after seven Sabbaths.
- The strong wind recalls the night wind that swept over the waters at creation and the breath of life that God blew into the human being.
- The tongues of fire at Pentecost symbolize a new call and a new covenant.

Reading II : 1 Corinthians 12:3-7, 12-13

There are different gifts, but the same Spirit.

- In I Corinthians, Paul describes the unity of Christians who are filled with the Holy Spirit.
- They are one body, breathing with the same breath.
- The gifts of each contribute to the life of the whole.

Gospel : John 20:19-23

As the Father sent me, so I send you.

- The Gospel reading portrays the timeless events of Jesus' resurrection and the descent of the Spirit.
- Jesus breathes on the disciples, creating them anew, and proclaims the gift of the Holy Spirit.
- Filled with the Spirit, the disciples continue to spread new life and remedy the separation caused by sin as they forgive sins.



Reading I Acts 2:1-11 | Psalm 104 | Reading II 1 Corinthians 12:3-7,12-13 | Gospel John 20: 19-23

Question For The Children When have you heard your inner voice or conscience guiding you to do what is right?

Question For The Youth When have you felt the Holy Spirit in your life?

Question For The Adults Share about times when you felt the power of the Spirit, giving you the right words, giving you insight into a dilemma, or in other ways.
