The Des Moines Area Religious Council (DMARC)

The DMARC Food Pantry Network continues to serve a growing number of people each year. Over 28k people utilized a DMARC Pantry last month-the busiest month in the nearly 50 year history of the DMARC Food Pantry Network. People seeking assistance in the Des Moines metro area can go to one of 14 partner food pantry sites or a mobile food pantry location to receive a three-day supply of food for themselves and their families once per month at no cost.

DMARC relies on support from generous contributors to provide this assistance. Support in the way of both food and non-food items, diapers (large sizes), formulas, baby food, baby wipes, personal products, etc. Items may be placed in one of the collection tubs in the collection location at the side entrance of the church. DMARC also welcomes cash donations as they are able to buy items at discounted prices. One-time or continuing donations may be made by using the **QR code system** now in place through the Church office or by email, <u>holytrinitydm.org/donate</u>

Twenty- first Sunday of Ordinary Time

Ordinary Time- For a large part of the liturgical year, we devote ourselves to listening to the mystery of Christ in all its aspects unfolded as we seek God's truth and understanding.

Reading I : Joshua 24:1-2a, 15-17, 18b

We will serve the Lord!

- The Book of Joshua describes the story of the Israelites as they take possession of the Promised Land.
- The people are a new generation of Israel.
- Joshua gathers the people in the center of the land at Shechem to renew their covenant commitment to God.

Reading II : Ephesians 5:21-32

Christ loves us as spouses love each other.

- The reading from the Letter to the Ephesians describes the mutual respect that should prevail in ordinary human relationships because of the new life shared in Christ.
- The relationship of marriage is particularly significant because the marriage relationship stands as a symbol of the covenant relationship between the people and God.
- The fidelity and love between wife and husband symbolize the fidelity and love between God and the people and between Christ and his Church.

Gospel : John 6:60-69

You have the words of eternal life.

- Jesus' divinity is clearly implied in the Gospel of John.
- In today's passage the disciples are faced with a choice.
- Peter, representing the Twelve, affirms their decision to stay with Jesus.
