Notes on the Mass | August 27, 2023

Twenty-first Sunday in Ordinary Time

Ordinary Time

For a large part of the liturgical year, we devote ourselves to listening to the mystery of Christ in all its aspects unfolded as we seek God's truth and understanding.

Reading I: Isaiah 22:19-23 | David will rule the people.

- The reading from the prophet Isaiah demands accountability from the existing leadership.
- Today's passage describes a ceremony of installation in which the robes and insignia of office were to be given to Eliakim.
- The key, placed on his shoulder, was a symbol of authority and power.

Reading II: Romans 11:33-36 | How deep is the wisdom of God!

- Paul concludes his thought about the mystery of God's choice of the Jews and God's mercy to the Gentiles.
- The hymn to divine wisdom acknowledges that only God knows.
- Salvation is available to both Jews and Gentiles.

Gospel : Matthew 16:13-20 | On this rock, I will build my church.

- The new name Jesus gives Simon Peter in today's Gospel, announces Peter as the "rock," the foundation of the Church.
- Peter is a very human leader with sins and imperfections.
- Jesus gives Peter the keys of the Kingdom of heaven.

Reading I Isaiah 22:19-23 | **Psalm** 138:1-3, 6, 8 | **Reading II** Romans 11:33-36 | **Gospel** Matthew 16:13-20

Question For The Children What are three things you know about Jesus?

Question For The Youth Today's Gospel is about identity – the revealing of Jesus' true self. How difficult is it to you to reveal your true self? What holds you back from being who God created you to be?

Question For The Adults If Jesus turned and asked you the same question, who would you say he is? How would you describe Jesus to someone who did not know him?

Activity Of The Week Create a collage that tells about Jesus. Cut pictures, words, or symbols out of magazines or newspapers and paste them on a paper plate. Display the collage in your home as a reminder of who Jesus is for your family.

St. Jane Frances de Chantal



Saint Of The Week Jane Frances de Chantal

Jane Frances was born in Dijon, France. At the age of twenty, she married Baron Christopher de Chantal. The couple had seven children, three of whom died in infancy. When her husband died in a hunting accident in 1601, Jane Frances sank into a depression. She and her children moved into her father-in-law's house when he threatened to disinherit her children. Despite his oppressiveness, she managed to regain her cheerfulness and raise her children in a happy atmosphere. Inspired by Francis de Sales, Jane made provisions for her children's care and, along with three other women, formed the first community of Visitation nuns. During the last years of her life, Jane suffered a spiritual dryness. She overcame these cares and worries by losing herself in God. "To live no more in oneself, but lost in God, is the most sublime perfection which the soul can reach," was Jane Frances' advice to those with misgivings and concerns.

Jane Frances de Chantal's message today:

All of us experience spiritual dryness at some point in our lives, a time when God seems to have abandoned us. Jane's advice "to live no more in oneself, but lost in God," offers wise words of counsel. We can persevere, as she did, in our faith life despite not feeling connected to God.

Do you remain faithful to God even when life is routine and you feel a lack of spirituality in your daily existence? Remember that God doesn't turn away from you at any time.
