



Twenty-third Sunday in Ordinary Time

Ordinary Time

For a large part of the liturgical year, we devote ourselves to listening to the mystery of Christ in all its aspects unfolded as we seek God's truth and understanding.

Reading I : Ezekiel 33:7-9 | The wicked will not prosper.

- Ezekiel is commissioned as a sentinel, with responsibility to warn God's people of impending danger.
- God's message was sent to the people through the prophet Ezekiel.
- The prophet must listen to God and deliver God's message and the people, for their own safety, must listen to the prophet and hear in the prophet's words the voice of God.

Reading II : Romans 13:8-10 | Whoever loves his or her neighbor, fulfills the law.

- The passage from the Letter to the Romans describes the unity demanded of Christians.
- Love is the fulfillment of the Law.
- The whole Law, in Hebrew Scriptures and in the New Testament, is summed up in love of neighbor and love of God.

Gospel : Matthew 18:15-20 | When you join yourselves together in faith, I am with you.

- The Gospel passage from Matthew contains practical advice for dealing with disagreements within the community and the theological foundation for this advice.
- The meaning of "binding and loosing" is the power of admission and excommunication.
- Today's passage gives the theological reason for such power. Where two or three are gathered together in unity, whether in prayer or deliberation, they will be heard by God.



Bring Home the Gospel | September 10, 2023

Reading I Ezekiel 33:7-9 | Psalm 95:1-2, 6-7, 8-9 | Reading II Romans 13:8-10 | Gospel Matthew 18:15-20

Question For The Children What is one thing you would do for someone whom you loved?

Question For The Youth Jesus tells us about the importance of community and friendship. When have you helped heal an argument between friends? How did that feel?

Question For The Adults How do you make sure you follow the way of love as described by Paul in today's reading? What steps do you take to eliminate the unloving — grudges, hatred, prejudice, or others.

Activity Of The Week Jesus said that when two or more people come together in his name — he will be there. To help your family experience the power of praying together, pray the Lord's Prayer aloud in unison. Pause for a moment of silence. Invite family members to silently pray for one another. Close by thanking God for the gifts of faith and family.



Saint Of The Week Vibiana

We know almost nothing about Saint Vibiana. What we do know is that in 1851, Pope Pius IX bought a vineyard located just outside of Rome. When ancient catacombs were discovered underneath the land, the pope directed the Pontifical Commission for Sacred Archeology to explore the vast underground network. About two years later, an intact tomb was uncovered which was sealed by a marble tablet. When the tomb was opened, the skeleton of a young woman was discovered. The markings on the tomb led officials to believe she had been a martyr. When the diocese of Monterey was established, the relics of Saint Vibiana were sent there with instructions to build a cathedral in her honor. To this day, she is honored for her faith.

Vibiana's message today:



This saint is remarkable in that we know so little about her life and death. But what is striking is that, through her intercession with God, she has interceded on behalf of many people in our times, and helped those who need her assistance.

Perhaps Vibiana can inspire you to help someone who has a need of your service. Ask her to seek direction for you.
