Dear Families,

I hope the school year is off to a great start. Though we are now just a few weeks into a new school year, I am writing with an important update regarding the enrollment process for the 2024-25 school year.

As you may be aware, in January of 2022 the twelve Catholic schools in Des Moines formed a new entity - Des Moines Regional Catholic Schools. The regional model allows us to centralize business functions, leverage collective resources and implement best business practices which will sustain the future of our schools. Some of the changes you will notice this year include a revised enrollment process which gives current families priority.

Enrollment for the 2024-25 school year will open October 2, 2023, for current families. The process must be completed by November 15, 2023, to receive priority. As a current family, you will receive priority admission for your student(s) now attending Holy Trinity as well as any children who will be enrolling for the first time in Early Childhood through 8th grade. Please note that enrollment for your new student will be determined by availability and our admission consideration process. After November 15, we will open enrollment to families in our parish. From there, we will open enrollment to new families in the broader community.

The enrollment fee will be \$100 per student and will be paid through a new system - Blackbaud Tuition Management. Blackbaud will replace FACTS for all fees and tuition management services beginning with the 2024-25 school year.

We are in the midst of the budget process to determine the tuition for the 2024-25 school year which will be shared no later than February. Affordability remains a top priority as the region works to increase teacher compensation to match public school pay within five years. Increases in tuition assistance through Catholic Tuition Organization (CTO), Diocesan Tuition Assistance (DTA) and other sources will help offset any tuition increases for families with demonstrated need. Many will also benefit now from Education Savings Accounts (ESAs) and all families will qualify for the 2025-26 school year. We can assure you that the financial impact for all families will be taken into account when establishing tuition. Please do not let cost deter you from registering your child at this time. We encourage all families to take advantage of these resources which will help fund a Catholic education for your child for years to come. To determine when your family will qualify for an ESA, please visit <https://educateiowa.gov/pk-12/students-first-education-savings-accounts>.

A communication will follow on October 2, 2023, which will provide instructions on steps for priority enrollment. We recognize that the revised enrollment process is taking place earlier than what you are accustomed to. We appreciate your assistance as we implement this new process. Twenty-fifth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Ordinary Time - For a large part of the liturgical year, we devote ourselves to listening to the mystery of Christ in all its aspects unfolded as we seek God's truth and understanding.

Reading I : Isaiah 55:6-9 | Seek the Lord while he may be found.

- In the reading from Isaiah, God's justice is measured by the demands of mercy.
- The prophet tells God's people in exile that a return to their land is possible.
- Only in faith would the people be able to seek the Lord and turn from their evil ways.

Reading II : Philippians 1:20c-24, 27a | To me, life means Christ.

- The Letter to the Philippians was written when Paul was imprisoned.
- In today's passage, Paul asks the Philippians to imitate Christ.
- Even in prison Paul was willing to continue working in the vineyard, knowing that his reward would be far greater than he could imagine.

Gospel : Matthew 20:1-16a | The parable of the vineyard.

- Throughout the Gospel of Matthew, the author gives new interpretations to Jewish laws.
- Today's parable shows the power and generosity of God, along with the need for human willingness.
- Jesus' parable teaches that God is merciful to all.

Question For The Children How do you experience God being generous to you: through your family, friends, school, or parish?

Question For The Youth This Gospel reminds us that God is always seeking us out and welcoming us into his generous love. Through whom has God reached out to you? Who is always encouraging you to say "yes" to God?

Question For The Adults Using Jesus' parable as your starting point, describe in your own words how God will treat those who come to be part of the church, even those who come late.

Activity Of The Week To help your family celebrate the Generosity of God, before grace at meals, join hands and thank God for the ways in which God has entered and become part of your life. Thank God for the individual blessings each one has received and for the family blessings.




Saint Of The Week - Matthew Matthew, probably the best educated of the Apostles, builds a logical case for Jesus as the Messiah to the Jewish people. In writing this Gospel, he shows a broad knowledge of what we today call the Old Testament. We all need to develop a familiarity with the Scripture if we are to understand the basics of our faith.

Matthew's Message Do you read Scripture on a daily basis? Have you considered joining a Bible study group?
