

FROM FATHER MARK | JANUARY 22, 2023

Greetings.

Well, we are now back in Ordinary Time for a brief period...in that short space between the Christmas Season and Lent. Our gospel accounts are once again about the daily ministry of Jesus. Ordinary Time is an interesting title for most of our liturgical year (33 weeks). We call it ordinary time, but there is nothing "ordinary" about the ministry of Jesus in the Gospels where he frequently performs miracles. The term comes from the fact that we are not anticipating the coming of Jesus (Advent and the birth of Jesus at Christmas) or his passion (Lent and his death/resurrection at Easter). Rather, we are walking with him in his daily life among us.

In our own "ordinary" daily lives, do we sometimes feel like things are anything but "ordinary"? There are the daily challenges, frustrations and sometimes emergencies; all of them needing to be dealt with. Jesus, in the gospels, takes things one day at a time and often does not seem to be in any particular hurry. He does this so we might also imitate him in our own lives. Specifically, he teaches us to take things one day at a time, one "crisis" at a time. Moreover, just as Jesus does in his own "ordinary" daily life in the gospels, be sure to take some opportunities for prayer, reflection and time with those most important to you.

Ordinary Time

For a large part of the liturgical year, we devote ourselves to listening to the mystery of Christ in all its aspects unfolded as we seek God's truth and understanding.

Reading I: Isaiah 8:23-9:3

The people who walked in darkness have seen a great light.

- In the first reading, Isaiah preaches to people who are discouraged by war and oppression.
- Among the first regions taken in the war were three sections of the northern Kingdom.
- The prophet promises that God will again restore the land.

Reading II: 1 Corinthians 1:10-13, 17

Let there be no factions among you.

- In today's second reading Paul gives his reaction to the divisions among the Corinthians.
- The factions in the Corinthian church were dividing Christ's Body.
- Paul insists that through Baptism all become members of one body, the Body of Christ.

Gospel: Matthew 4:12-23

Come with me.

- Because a majority of Matthew's audience seems to have been Jewish Christians, the passage from Isaiah is used in today's Gospel to explain the fact that Jesus' ministry began in Galilee, not Jerusalem.
- The substance of Jesus' preaching is summarized, "Repent, for the Kingdom of heaven is at hand."
- Jesus' preaching calls for a radical change, the old way of living must be abandoned and a new way embraced.



Saint Of The Week Angela Merici

Angela Merici was orphaned at the age of ten. Raised by an uncle, she eventually entered religious life and lived in prayer and austerity. She founded a school for poor children and eventually founded the Ursuline order, who were sisters that lived in their own homes and gave future wives and mothers a solid Christian education. Even today, the work of the Ursuline nuns stresses religious education for girls, especially the poor.
