Second Sunday of Advent

Advent

The twofold character of Advent calls us to prepare for the remembering of the Word made Flesh at Christmas, and directs us to wait with alertness for Jesus' second coming.

Reading I : Isaiah 11:1-10

The wolf shall be a guest of the lamb.

- The reading from Isaiah describes the expected Emmanuel God with us.
- The reign of Emmanuel will be harmonious, just, and peace-filled. The one who comes will be a person of justice and wisdom.
- The characteristics or qualities of Emmanuel are what Christians today identify as the Gifts of the Holy Spirit.

Reading II : Romans 15:4-9

Accept one another, as Christ accepted you.

- In the passage from the Letter to the Romans, Paul urges the strong to carry the burdens of the weak, to follow the example of Christ, who became the servant of all.
- Followers of Christ ought to build the community and its members up rather than tear it down.
- Paul calls for unity and acceptance, between the Gentile Christians who were the majority and the Jewish-Christian minority.

Gospel : Matthew 3:1-12

Reform your lives!

- In the Gospel of Matthew, John the Baptist is introduced preaching a message of conversion: "Reform your lives! The reign of God is at hand."
- John the Baptists' preaching demanded a radical conversion of the whole person to God.
- John baptized the people in the River Jordan as a symbolic washing that signified their repentance, but this is a Jewish, not a Christian baptism. On this Sunday, we focus on preparation for Christ.




Reading I Isaiah 11:1-10 | Psalm 72:1-2, 7-8, 12-13, 17 | Reading II Romans 15:4-9 | Gospel Matthew 3:1-12

Question For The Children What do you hope will happen in your family this Christmas (besides gifts)?

Question For The Youth What are the greatest challenges you face as a young person today in terms of allowing Christ to be your teacher and following him?

Question For The Adults Name the one thing in your life which you must "move out of the way" in order to make more room for Christ – a grudge, a possession, a memory, hurt, or feeling.

Activity Of The Week Make a prayer list of members of your community, family, or friends who have died in the past year. Place the list in a special prayer space in your home. Every day this week, say a prayer for the people on the list.



Saint Of The Week Juan Diego, Farmer

Juan Diego was a poor Aztec Indian who lived in Mexico. They raised vegetables on their little farm, and every Saturday he took them to the local market to sell them to help support his family. He always went to Mass on those trips into the town. One Sunday, on his way to Mass, Juan heard beautiful music and saw a lady wearing a blue veil and a dress the color of roses. He saw right away that this was Mary, the mother of God. Juan was sent by Mary to ask the local bishop to build a chapel there where people could pray to her. He did as told, and today we honor him for trusting in her word.

Pope John Paul II canonized this saint on July 31, 2002 at the Basilica of Our Lady of Guadalupe. Saint Juan Diego is honored by the Church with a memorial on December 9, the date of his first vision.

Juan's message today:

Although Juan was a man of very simple means, he was not afraid to speak to the bishop when emboldened by Mary's request. Our faith can help us to speak boldly as well, whether it be in the name of justice or simply to help someone in need.
