

Fifth Sunday of Lent

Lent

Forty days before the Triduum, the Lenten season disposes Catechumens and the faithful to celebrate the paschal mystery through prayer and penitential practices.

Reading I: Ezekiel 37:12-14

I will put my spirit in you.

- The reading from Ezekiel is part of a longer vision of the movement from death to new life.
- Ezekiel was preaching to the exiles in Babylon who were convinced that as a people, they were dead.
- Ezekiel understood that the power of life belonged to God alone.

Reading II: Romans 8:8-11

You are in the Spirit.

- In the second reading, Paul stresses that life in the Spirit is the true life that Jesus came to bring.
- The death of Jesus led to the gift of everlasting life for those who believe in him.
- The Spirit of God, who raised Jesus from the dead, dwells in believers and will also bring their deathbound bodies to life.

Gospel : John 11:1-45

I am the resurrection and the life.

- The story of Lazarus is a drama that plays between two understandings of life and death.
- Jesus announces that he himself is the Resurrection. Lazarus, though raised, will die again. This is
 different from the Resurrection of Christ.
- Lazarus rises again to this present earthly life. This miracle is a sign of the greatest miracle of all, resurrection.



BRING HOME THE GOSPEL | MARCH 26, 2023

Reading I Ezekiel 37:12-14 | **Psalm** 130:1-8 | **Reading II** Romans 8:8-11 | **Gospel** John 11:1-45

Question For The Children How do your actions show that you put your faith and trust in Jesus?

Question For The Youth Lazarus received a second chance at life through Jesus. How have you experienced second chances in your own life?

Question For The Adults The death from which we are called is healing from those things which bind us and hold us back: memories, fears, rejection, or other such things. What binds you? What keeps you from fully being your own most true self in Christ?

Activity Of The Week God wants us to live and to enjoy the world and people around us. Give each family member a small slip of paper. Have each person write down one thing that keeps him or her from enjoying life. When ready, invite family members to quietly place the slip of paper in a garbage can. Pray a little prayer to thank Jesus for calling you back to life.



Saint Of The Week Veronica

Matthew's and Luke's Gospels tell of the large number of women following Jesus on the Way of the Cross who were grieving over his condemnation. While there is no specific mention of the incident in the Scriptures, Tradition tells us that when Jesus fell, one of the women in the crowd who saw his suffering rushed forward with a veil to wipe his bloody face. This was a simple act perhaps, but it was an indication of the sorrow felt by these women who had been Jesus' disciples. Jesus' gift to the woman was the image of his face on the cloth. We know this woman as Veronica. Her love and understanding for Jesus would not allow her to step aside while he was suffering.

Veronica message today:

Showing compassion for a suffering human being is never out of date. Many in our world today need your help. Are you aware of those in need around you? In other parts of the world? Have you done anything about those who are suffering?
