NOTES ON THE MASS | MAY 14, 2023

Sixth Sunday of Easter

The sound of Alleluias fills the 50 days of Easter Sunday to Pentecost as we give thanks for the gift of our salvation. The Easter Triduum recalls the passion and resurrection of Christ in the sacred journey from Holy Thursday to Easter Vigil. "Dying he destroyed our death. Rising he restored our life."

Reading I: Acts 8:5-8, 14-17

They prayed to receive the Holy Spirit.

- In today's first reading, we discover how people come to hear and believe in Jesus.
- The people in Samaria believed in Jesus and were baptized.
- Peter and John came from Jerusalem to pray over the Samaritans and lay their hands on them; a prayerful gesture of intercession and blessing that is still part of the Church's sacramental rituals.

Reading II: 1 Peter 3:15-18

Christ died for sins once for all.

- Today's second reading, from the First Letter of Peter, speaks of how Christians are to live.
- The passage ends with a reference to the Resurrection.
- The risen Christ lives a new and glorious life that we who have been baptized in his name and sealed with the gift of the Spirit will also receive.

Gospel: John 14:15-21

If you love me, obey my commandments.

- Today's Gospel is taken from Jesus' farewell address to his disciples.
- The author of today's Gospel emphasizes the union of Jesus with the Father and with believers.
- In Jesus, believers also stand in relationship with the Father. This relationship is made possible and real through the gift of the Holy Spirit.



BRING HOME THE GOSPEL | MAY 14, 2023

Reading I Acts 8:5-8, 14-17 | **Psalm** 66:1-3, 4-5, 6-7, 16, 20 | **Reading II** 1 Peter 3:15-18 | **Gospel** John 14:15-21

Question For The Children Jesus promises to be our friend forever. How do friends treat each other?

Question For The Youth Jesus promised us that the Holy Spirit (the Advocate) would remain with us always. When have you experienced the Spirit?

Question For The Adults Which one of the promises in today's Gospel gives you the most hope?

Activity Of The Week Take out any symbols or pictures of your Confirmation or the Confirmation of other members of the family. Talk about what you remember about the day. Discuss how the Holy Spirit was present that day and how you continue to experience the presence of the Holy Spirit in your life today.



Saint Of The Week Justin

Justin, a layman, lived in the very early years of the Church. He was a great teacher and his writings remain with us today. He was an historian who wrote about the Christian faith. He explained the Eucharist and other celebrations, to help many people come to the faith. He often debated pagan scholars of the day, and was eventually tortured and killed because of that. We honor him today for this great contribution to the Church.

Justin's message today:

Justin searched for a time before finding God. Once he had found God, he kept the faith even to death.

Although martyrdom may not be the fate of any of us, we should be prepared to defend our faith at any given moment.

All of us face temptations daily which would lead us away from God. Ask God to help you to grow in faith and you will be able to stand up to the temptations.
