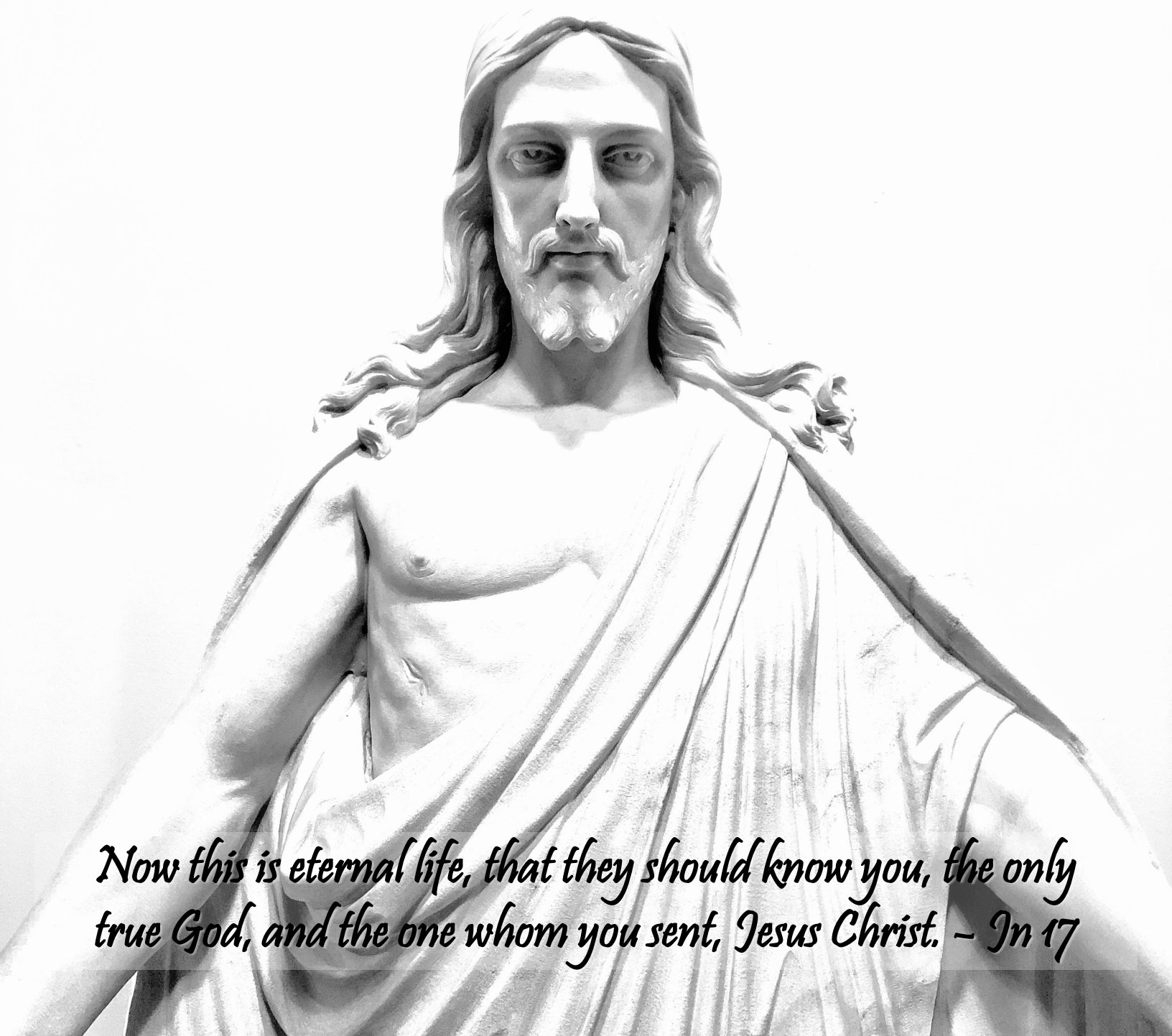

FROM FATHER MARK | MAY 21, 2023

- The per pupil funding for the 2023-24 school year will be \$7,635. The following students are eligible for the 2023-24 school year: All students entering kindergarten, all public school students transferring to a private school, and current private school students who meet income qualification guidelines.

- All applications must be submitted by June 30, 2023 to receive funds for the upcoming school year. Students who transfer mid-year are not eligible.
 - Applications will be completed online. The link will be available at educateiowa.gov by May 31, 2023. Application process should take no more than 10-15 minutes and results will be available immediately.
 - There will be just one application per family. Parents/guardians can add multiple students attending multiple schools from their household.
- Application consists of basic questions including contact information and social security number/ITIN. The State of Iowa will verify household size and net income (line 26 of the 2022 Iowa 1040 tax form).
 - Each student will have an account that parents can access through an online portal. Parents will direct payment of funds to schools after July 15.

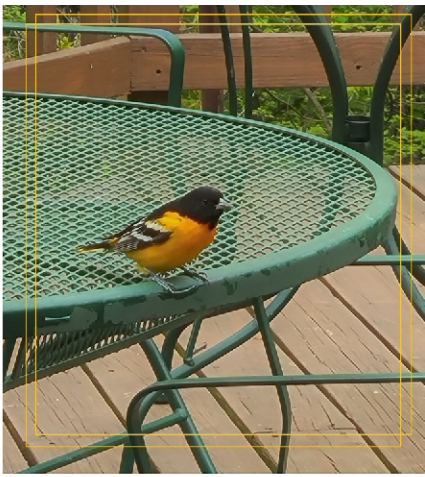

Seventh Sunday of Easter

The sound of Alleluias fills the 50 days of Easter Sunday to Pentecost as we give thanks for the gift of our salvation. The Easter Triduum recalls the passion and resurrection of Christ in the sacred journey from Holy Thursday to Easter Vigil. "Dying he destroyed our death. Rising he restored our life."

Reading I : Acts 1:12-14

They were all gathered in the upper room, waiting.

- Today's first reading refers to a time when the early Christians were "in-between" their experience of Jesus' presence with them and their experience of the promised Holy Spirit.
- The Apostles, Mary, and other believers return to Jerusalem after the death of Jesus.
- They are strengthened as a community through support of one another and prayer.

Reading II : 1 Peter 4:13-16

If you suffer for something, let it be for Christ.

- In the second reading, Christians living in the time "between" Pentecost and the second coming of Jesus at the end of time are reminded that their conduct should promote unity and harmony rather than destroy it.
- At the time this letter was written, the Christian community was finding it hard to endure persecution.
- Peter warns them that following Christ might result in hardships, but that any suffering in God's name will lead to future glory.

Gospel : John 17:1-11a

Jesus prays to his Father.

- Today's Gospel is part of Jesus' Last Supper discourse. Jesus' address is not to the disciples but to God.
- In today's passage, Jesus prays for himself, for the disciples and for all future believers, as he approaches his death.
- For the disciples, still in this world, Jesus prays that they will be united in a unity on earth as close as the unity between him and the Father.



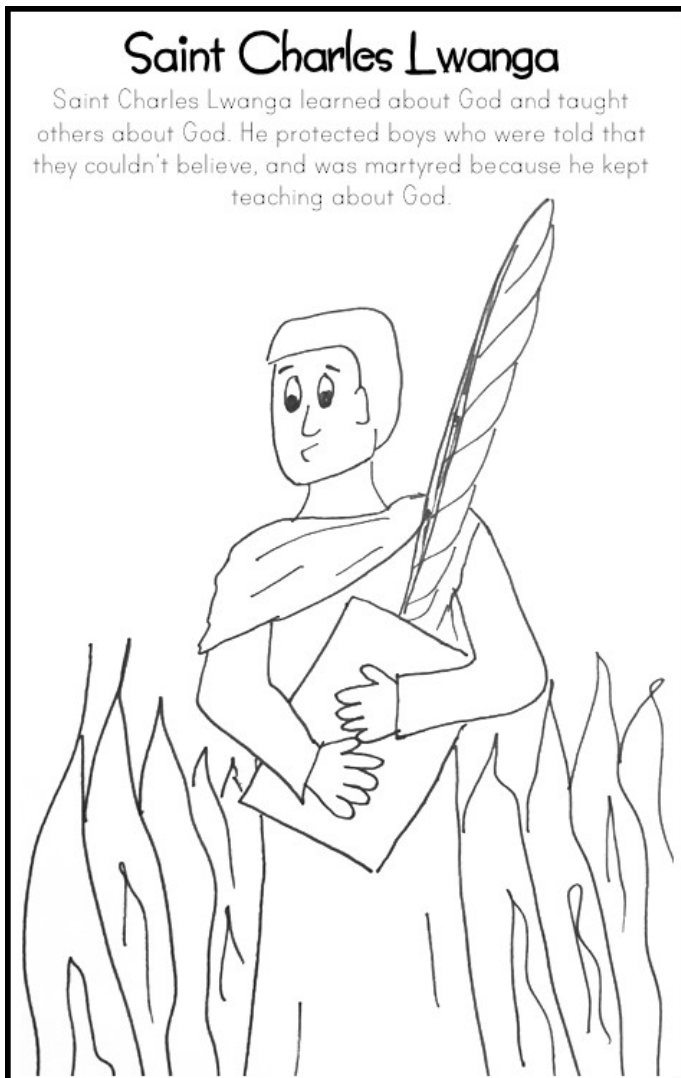
Reading I Acts 1:12-14 | Psalm 27:1, 4, 7-8 | Reading II 1 Peter 4:13-16 | Gospel John 17:1-11a

Question For The Children Jesus helps us be strong in our faith. When do you need to be really strong in faith?

Question For The Youth Prayer is essential to being a disciple, because it is the way we build or relationship with God—through talking and listening. What is one way you can take more time this week to listen to God in prayer?

Question For The Adults In these heartfelt instructions from a leader of the church, what are the ways in modern life that we sometimes suffer for our faith? Or are there no such ways?

Activity Of The Week Prayer is our communication with God and our awareness of God all around us. Nature places us in communication with God because in nature we experience the awesome wonder of God's goodness. Take a family nature walk or nature trip near your home. Experience the wonder of spring, the newness of life, and the sounds of God's creation.



Saint Of The Week Charles Lwanga and Companions

Charles Lwanga lived in Uganda, Africa. He was baptized on the very day that his own teacher was murdered for the faith. Because he refused to take part in the immorality of the day, he was sent to prison. Enroute, three of his companions, including Lwanga, were murdered, burned to death along with two soldiers. Saint Charles Lwanga, together with twenty one other martyrs, was canonized in 1964 by Pope Paul VI. He has been named the patron of African youth. He and his companion martyrs are honored on June 3.

Charles Lwanga's message today:

What strong faith this young man had! Knowing that it would probably lead to his own martyrdom, he persevered in his request for Baptism. Then he stood up to the king, defending himself and others against what he knew to be wrong.

Think of some ways that you can help a young person affirm their faith. Pray for those in your parish who are to be confirmed this year.
