



# Palm Sunday

#### Lent

Forty days before the Triduum, the Lenten season disposes Catechumens and the faithful to celebrate the paschal mystery through prayer and penitential practices.

#### Reading I: Matthew 21:1-11 (Procession with palms) | Isaiah 50:4-7

This is the prophet Jesus from Nazareth. (Procession with palms) | The Lord God is my help.

- The reading from Isaiah is part of the third Servant Song.
- The song communicates the servant's belief that, no matter how cruel or indifferent people are, God's justice will prevail.
- Suffering is never an end in itself.

#### Reading II: Philippians 2:6-11

Your attitude must be Christ's.

- Paul's letter to the Philippians was written while Paul was in prison in Rome.
- Despite being imprisoned, Paul expresses confidence and joy in the Lord.
- Paul stresses that our salvation is Jesus' kenosis, the Greek word for Jesus' "emptying" of himself from glory.

#### Gospel: Matthew 26:14-27:66 or Matthew 27:11-54

The passion of our Lord Jesus Christ.

- The Passion Narrative is among the earliest traditions to be handed down in written form.
- In Matthew's passion account, all the events proceed according to God's will as revealed in the Hebrew Scriptures.
- Jesus, the servant and Son of God, has poured himself out to overcome humanity's separation from God.



# BRING HOME THE GOSPEL | APRIL 2, 2023

Reading I Matt. 21:1-11 & Isaiah 50:4-7 | Psalm 22:8-9, 17-20, 23-24 | Reading II Philippians 2:6-11 | Gospel Matt. 27:11-54

**Question For The Children** Share how you sometimes make sacrifices for the good of others.

**Question For The Youth** Today begins the holiest week of the year. It is a once-a-year opportunity to really reflect on Jesus life, death, and resurrection. How will you enter into this experience? How will you be open to how you might be changed?

**Question For The Adults** Name one specific way that you live your baptismal call to enter into the death of the Lord by forgiveness, generosity, hospitality, or other ways.

**Activity Of The Week** To make this Holy Week special, turn off the television set for the entire week. You may want to put a crucifix or a picture of Jesus on your table. Put a palm branch with it. Have a family discussion about what each person can do to grow closer to Jesus this week.



## Saint Of The Week George

Saint George is said to have gone into the public square of his town, and announced loudly that the Christian God is the only true God. For this he was arrested and was tortured unmercifully. Throughout his suffering, he knew that Jesus was with him, suffering with him. His courage became legendary, and we honor him today for that.


