Ministries at Holy Trinity

Pastoral Care. Nourish for Caregivers is for anyone juggling the challenges of life, health and career while caring for an aging parent, grandparent, or spouse, either in your home, in town or at a distance. Nourish provides family caregivers practical and emotional supports, shared experiences and useful tools, all with a Christ-centered view.

In the chaotic hustle of the day-to-day juggling of work and home life, caregivers often forget that they don't have to do it all. Asking for help is not easy. We tend to want to go it all alone, taking burdens on our shoulders, or maybe expecting others to read our mind, knowing we desperately need help. There is help, and hope, available.

SAINT OF THE WEEK

Blaise, Bishop and Martyr

Bishop Blaise was martyred around 316 and we believe that he was a good bishop who encouraged the spiritual and physical health of his people. He cared for animals who were sick and wounded, and is said to have healed a young boy who was choking. Today we look to Sr. Blaise as the protector of the sick, especially those with illnesses of the throat.

All of God's creatures, great and small, are entitled to our care and compassion. There are many people, young and old, who may not be able to look after their own needs.

It is up to us to help them in whatever way we can. Are you aware of the needs in your own community? What can you do to alleviate the suffering of others? Many Catholics in this country still have their throats blessed on St. Blaise's feast day, February 3.

Blaise's message today: All of God's creatures, great and small, are entitled to our care and compassion. There are many people, young and old, who may not be able to look after their own needs. It is up to us to help them in whatever way we can.

COURAGE, EXPLAINED!

Virtues, Explained

In the Roman Rite, bishops extend their hands over confirmandi, praying that they will be given "a spirit of right judgment and courage."

This invocation echoes countless passages of sacred Scripture extolling the virtue of courage. "Be strong and courageous in your hearts, all you who place your hope in the Lord," says Psalm 31:25. "I have given you a command. Be strong and brave, do not be afraid nor dismayed. I, the Lord, your God, will be with you wherever you go," the Lord says in Joshua 1:9. Courage is also a frequent watchword of Christ: "Take courage! I have overcome the world." (John 16:33)

The virtue of courage is intimately linked with that of fortitude — roughly understood as courage in action — and is shown by the person who makes a choice to place his trust in God, not in circumstance.

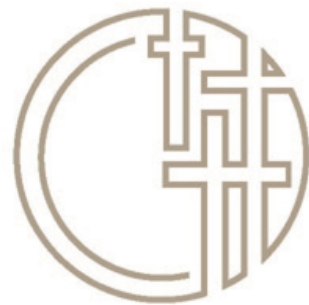

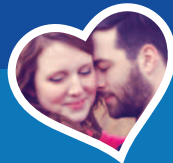

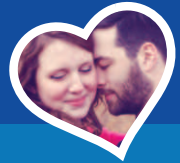
