OUR FAITH EXPLAINED



SAINT OF THE WEEK

Barnabas, Apostle and Martyr, First Century

Barnabas was mentioned in the Acts of Apostles for selling his estate and laying the money from the sale at the feet of the Apostles as an example of Christian calling. He had a strong influence on the other Apostles and was active in the early councils and missionary activity of the Church. Barnabas took in Saint Paul when others were suspicious of his conversion.

He traveled with Paul on Paul's first missionary journey to Mediterranean ports. They gained many converts to Christianity. He was stoned to death at Salamis.

We celebrate this saint's life with a memorial on June 11.

Barnabas' message today: Barnabas sold all of his possessions and laid the money at the feet of the Apostles. We are not asked to take such drastic steps in support of our community, but we are asked to support the church community in those ways that we can.

VIRTUES, EXPLAINED!

Honesty, Explained!

If the question were posed: "Who is God?" a variety of answers could be given, and more than one could be correct.

The most succinct, however, would be this: God is truth.

"I am the Way, the Truth and the Life," Jesus tells his disciples (John 14:6). The pursuit of truth, he further instructs, will set them free (John 8:32) from the original untruth uttered and embraced in Eden.

If God is truth, he is honored by truthfulness. Untruthfulness, not surprisingly, is synonymous with disorder and broken relationships among mankind — Eden's everlasting legacy. The virtue of honesty, writes St. Thomas Aquinas, is "a kind of spiritual beauty" which measures the degree to which we honor one another in how we live truthfully (Sum. II:II, 145, Art 1-4).

Honesty is something that must be known interiorly in order to be visible exteriorly: "Teach me your way, O Lord, that I may walk in your Truth" (Psalm 86:11).
