CTO TUITION ASSISTANCE APPLICATION NOW OPEN FOR 2026–27

Learn more on how to save

The application cycle for tuition assistance through the Catholic Tuition Organization (CTO) and Diocesan Tuition Assistance (DTA) is now open for the 2026–27 school year.

Eligibility Highlights:

- Iowa families who meet income guidelines based on household size may apply.
- Students must be 5 years old by September 15, 2026 (Kindergarten or Transitional Kindergarten).
- Preschool students are not eligible.
- Only one application is required per family.

Important Details:

- Application deadline: May 5, 2026
- Application fee: \$31
- Families should be prepared to submit their 2024 or 2025 Federal Tax Return (Form 1040) and any required supporting documents.

Families are encouraged to apply if their household income falls within the eligibility limits.

Participants will have the opportunity to view all seven volumes of the Heritage Edition of The Saint John's Bible, loaned to St. Catherine's by Chuck and Janet Haas of Des Moines. The one-hour presentation will be followed by a reception.

The Saint John's Bible is the first handwritten, illuminated Bible commissioned by a Benedictine Abbey in over 500 years. Called "one of the extraordinary undertakings of our time" by Smithsonian Magazine, it has been displayed at major museums and houses of worship throughout the world.

OUR FAITH EXPLAINED



SAINT OF THE WEEK

Francisco and Jacinta, Children, d. 1919 and 1920

One has a tendency to think that, short of martyrdom, saints lived relatively long lives devoted to prayer and good works. Francisco and Jacinta Marto, ages 11 and 10 at their deaths, demonstrate to us that even young children — maybe especially young children — are very close to God and can also become saints. These children lived in a small village near Fatima, Portugal. Like other children, they were sent out into the fields to shepherd the flocks. Beginning on May 13, 1917, the children were visited several times by the Blessed Virgin Mary near Fatima. During these visits, Our Lady also exhorted them to pray for sinners and revealed three “secrets” to them. Today, Fatima is a holy shrine visited by many pilgrims.

We are all “our brother’s keepers” and our prayers and sacrifices are vital to the salvation of souls. In a world that seems to move further away from God with each passing year, we must redouble our efforts to bring about the conversion of sinners.

A memorial to Our Lady of Fatima may be celebrated on this date. Francisco and Jacinta are honored in Portugal on February 20.

Francisco and Jacinta's message today: We are all “our brother’s keepers” and our prayers and sacrifices are vital to the salvation of souls. In a world that seems to move further away from God with each passing year, we must redouble our efforts to bring about the conversion of sinners.

Seven Sorrows of Mary, Explained

The Seven Sorrows of Mary refer to seven key events in the lives of Jesus and Mary: the prophecy of Simeon, the flight into Egypt, the loss of the Child Jesus in Jerusalem, the meeting of Jesus and Mary as he carried his cross to Calvary, the Crucifixion and death of Jesus, the removal of the Body of Christ from the cross, and the burial of Jesus.

These events illustrate the great suffering endured by Our Lord and his Blessed Mother, and remind Christians to unite our own sufferings with those of Jesus, following Mary’s perfect example.

Devotion to the sorrows of Mary dates to the early centuries of Christianity, with such proponents as St. Ephrem, St. Alphonsus Liguori and St. Bridget of Sweden.

The Seven Sorrows devotion can take the form of seven Hail Marys, seven Rosaries or a novena, all recited while meditating upon the individual sorrows.



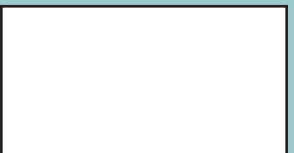

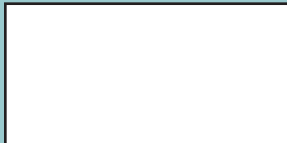
