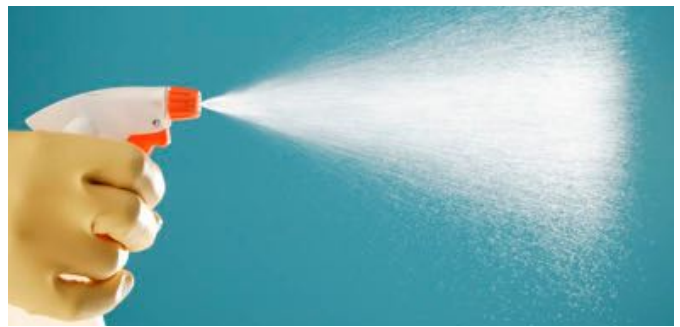

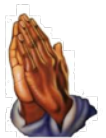

### RETURN TO LEARN PLAN JULY 7 DRAFT

#### DAILY PRECAUTIONS

All students, staff and visitors will have their temperature taken upon arrival.

#### PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT

Students will be encouraged to wear face masks or shields when physical distancing is not possible.

#### APPROPRIATE DISTANCING MEASURES

To the extent possible, we will practice the safest possible physical distancing including high traffic times such as lunch and recess.

#### HEALTHY HYGIENE

Hand sanitizer will be available in hallways and classrooms. Daily routines will include regular handwashing practices and cleaning of regularly touched surfaces.

#### ACADEMIC DAYS

School will begin on Monday August 24 with regular instructional programming for students K-8 Grade. Preschool and Pre-Kindergarten begins on Sept 1.

#### LIMIT LARGE GATHERINGS AND SHARING OF MATERIALS

Plans to limit large groups, including Mass, and other whole school events are being developed. There will be no community use of materials. Students should utilize individual water bottles and water filling stations.

#### DISTANCE LEARNING PLAN

Holy Trinity is building upon its robust instructional practices that can transfer from classroom to home should future stay-at-home orders be issued.

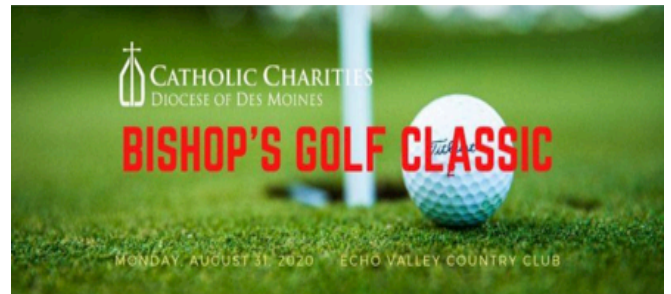

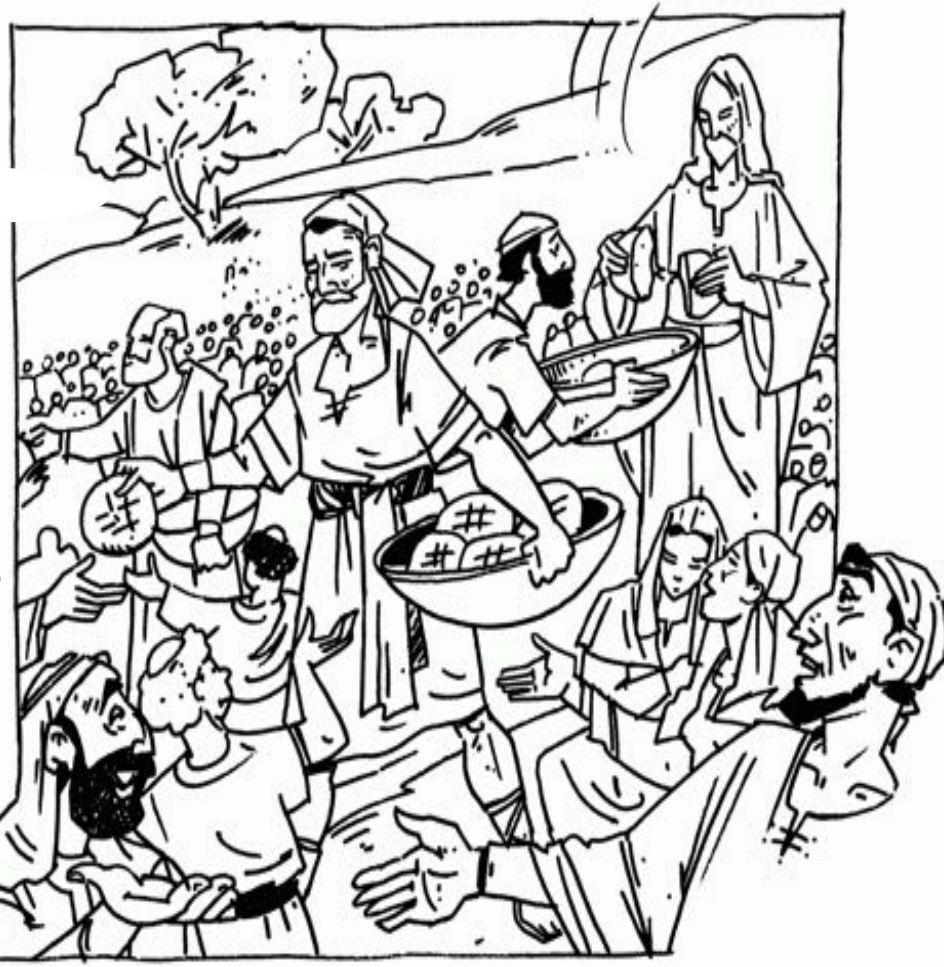

SAINT OF THE WEEK

### **Dominic, Priest**

Saint Dominic was a priest and teacher, whose wisdom and ability to speak about the faith was legendary. Once on a trip, he and his companion passed through a town in France which was beset by a great heresy of belief. Dominic, feeling kindness toward their host who professed this heresy, spent the whole night in discussion with him. As a result, the man rejected the heresy. It is commonly thought that this was when Dominic recognized what God's work for him was to be. Following this time, Dominic took the first steps toward establishing a preaching order to become known as the Dominicans who helped stop heresy throughout the Church. Dominic was known not only as a great preacher, but also as a gentle, charitable, and humble person. Dominic had great faith in God. With this gift, he was able to turn back a heresy and perform miracles. God has given the same gift to each of us and if we strengthen that faith, anything is possible to us. As Jesus told us, "if your faith is the size of a mustard seed...nothing will be impossible for you." (Mt 17:20)

## NOTES ON THE MASS AUG 2 2020

### SPIRITUALITY OF THE READINGS

#### **Come to the Water**

I love the [First Reading](#). I suppose this is obvious from the fact that I wrote a hymn, "[Come to the Water](#)," which is based on it.

It was a long time ago (1971), but I remember the time clearly. The St. Louis Jesuits were only just forming and we took a summer together to write, out in Berkeley, CA. We always composed music individually and then presented it to one another for critique. For my part I wrote two hymns, and when it was time, played them for the others. I remember the exact spot where I stood.

You probably think one of them was *Come to the Water*, but it wasn't. I don't even remember the names of those two pieces. The unanimous reaction of my brothers in Christ was, "ugh." "They just don't work," "What were you thinking?" These encouraged me to file the errant pieces in the round file and try again.

I had learned something. I could not just "dash off" music. I had to believe in it and believe in what it was saying. So I searched the scriptures and prayed. The result? A setting of the [First Reading](#) for this Sunday.

All you who are thirsty,  
come to the water!  
You who have no money,  
come, receive grain and eat;  
Come, without paying and without cost,  
drink wine and milk!  
Why spend your money for what is not bread;  
your wages for what fails to satisfy?  
Heed me, and you shall eat well,

you shall delight in rich fare.  
Composers and authors actually do not know what happens when inspiration hits. I only know that I began writing immediately, and that something inside was guiding me. *Come to the Water* was born.

I continue to believe in it and to stand behind what it says. Both the song and the scripture passage express a solution to the needs and aches in our bodies and souls. The love we received when we were children was true, in spite of whatever wounds and reversals any of us received then or afterwards. The inside chambers of our self are truly and thoroughly loved by the giving-God.

Jesus shows this to us in the [Gospel](#). He was aching, himself. He had been told about the death of dear his teacher and friend, John the Baptist. He wanted to get away from people, to let himself feel the loss.

But look what happened. Crowds of people tracked his boat and figured out where he was headed. They ran around the lake and waited as he pulled up to shore. Gone was his chance to mourn, at least for the moment. Maybe he should have told them to go away! Come back later. But the scripture says, "his heart was moved with pity for them, and he cured their sick."

Even more, he gave them food, a tiny bit of food that multiplied so there was enough. If you look at it, he was doing exactly what the [First Reading](#) and *Come to the Water* are talking about.

We are meant to be fed by God in this way. And we are to be like Jesus in our actions toward other people. What we receive as we walk up the aisle to communion makes us into God's way of fulfilling the [First Reading](#).
