#### STEM@HT

Last week, Holy Trinity received a Mathematics Scale-Up Program award for Differentiated Math Centers from the Iowa Governor's STEM Advisory Council! This award supports three levels of hands-on math activities for each K-5 classroom. By providing different levels of learning, we are able to make content accessible to every single student, providing help to those who need it and challenge to those who are ready for more. This is the FIFTH Scale-Up STEM program award we have received!2019 -"Differentiated Math Centers" for grades K-5: Three different levels of math manipulatives

2019 - "Pint Size Science" for grades K-2: Hands-on discovery learning of early STEM concepts

2018 - "STEM in Action" for grades PS-5: Utilizes the Engineering Design Process for problem-based learning

2017 - "Ramps and Pathways" for grades PS3 - K: Constructivist approach to early childhood physics, engineering and design

2016 - "Engineering is Elementary" for grades 1-5: Design challenge units that blend literacy, math, and science concepts

Each of these awards fund not only materials but STEM professional development for every educator in that grade. Because of the overlap in grades for these awards, many of our staff have been blessed to attend *multiple* STEM trainings over the past few years! We are grateful to the lowa Governor's STEM Advisory Council for this award and our staff for embedding these 21st century skills into their classrooms daily. 

# Elizabeth of Hungary,

## Wife, Mother and Religious, 1207-1231

Elizabeth became known for her great charity. Despite her high station, she led a life of prayer and penance and service to the poor. She built hospitals to care for the common people and daily took food to the poor. **Elizabeth's message today:** Many times, married people who become saints do so in spite of their spouses. Elizabeth's charitable works, however, were fully supported by her husband, who also became a saint, Blessed Ludwig of Thuringia. They give us an example of how married life should be a state of mutual love, respect, and support.
