

GREETINGS.

I have brief update for the parish this week.

Our weekday Mass schedule will be changing slightly. Beginning the week after the July 4th holiday our weekday Masses will be Tuesday and Wednesday at 8 AM, Thursday at 6 pm, and Friday at 8 AM. We will maintain the once a week evening Mass for the time being. Our weekend schedule will be the normal schedule for now of 4:30 on Saturday and 8:30 and 10:30 on Sunday morning.

Our first weekend back to public Masses went well. Our numbers were as follows: Saturday 4:30, 53 people, Sunday 8:30 am, 53 people, and Sunday 10:30 am, 76 people. There is ample room for more people with very good social distancing in effect. Thank you for your cooperation with new procedures. It was great to see people in the church again and the music was excellent! We look forward to seeing you.

On June 30th, we were able to have our 8th Grade graduation Mass. It was a bit later than originally planned, but so nice to see the kids again and be able to celebrate with them this step in their journey. We wish them all the best in high school!

An update on the annual appeal: We currently have 286 pledges for a total of \$99,375. This is out of 1250 parish households. Our assessment this year is \$108,155. Again, thank you so much to all those who have made such generous pledges thus far. If you've not yet had a chance to make a pledge or gift, please give this your most prayerful consideration. We need everyone's help in order to make our assessment. If we don't make our assessment, the difference will have to be made up out of our operating funds. If we go over our assessment, the difference stays here at Holy Trinity for our use.

May God continue to bless us all and may God bless Holy Trinity.

We have begun to plan for Communion Home Visits for those who find themselves isolated due to the Covid-19 pandemic. Please inform Sandy Stacy, Pastoral Care Minister if you desire to receive Communion in your home.

It is our plan to offer Communion Visits once a month to our Parishioners. The Homebound ministers will be required to wear a mask. The Parishioners are strongly encouraged to wear a mask, with the exception of the reception communion. We will practice the use of hand sanitizer and six-foot distancing with the exception of the reception of communion. When possible, the communion service should be practiced outside.

### BRING THE GOSPEL HOME JULY 5 2020

READING I: Zechariah 9:9-10

PSALM: 145: 1-14

READING II: Romans 8:9-13

GOSPEL: Matthew 11:25-30

Question for Children: When you are generous, honest, and loving, how do you know it is Jesus who helps you do that

Question for Youth: Jesus invites us to bring him our burdens and promises us that he will give us rest. How do you rely on Jesus during times of trouble? When has Jesus helped you?

Question for Adults: As you go about your daily life, dying in love for others, how do you experience Christ giving you consolation and peace?



### Elizabeth of Portugal, Wife, Mother and Religious

Elizabeth from was a royal family and was destined for a throne from birth, but her early upbringing taught her humility and a strong sense of charity. At the age of twelve, Elizabeth was married to Denis, King of Portugal. Elizabeth earned the title of "Peacemaker" because she frequently intervened between quarreling members of her family. In the royal milieu of the time, family quarrels often turned into wars. On two occasions, Elizabeth came between the forces of her husband and of her son. Two other times, she either averted war or intervened in disputes between rulers of Spanish kingdoms.

In our times, maintaining peace in one's family does not usually involve averting a war. But peace among family members is no less important—or no less difficult to achieve—than it was in Elizabeth's time.

Where do you stand in your family? Are you a peacemaker? The contentious one? What can you do to bring peace where there is dissension?





### NOTES ON THE MASS JULY 5 2020

SPIRITUALITY OF THE READINGS

#### Go Gentle

In the <u>Gospel</u> this week, how beautiful Jesus words are, and yet so hard to trust.

"Come to me, all you who labor and are burdened, and I will give you rest.

Take my yoke upon you and learn from me, for I am meek and humble of heart; and you will find rest for yourselves. For my yoke is easy, and my burden light."

What a great comfort these promises are. There is a place to go to when death or loss or suffering descend upon us.

Another very honest viewpoint is given by <u>Dylan Thomas</u>, the poet, who was in no way wiser than Jesus, but nevertheless deserves to be heard. He wrote this to his dying father:

"Do not go gentle into that good night,
Old age should burn and rave at close of day;
Rage, rage against the dying of the light.<u>\*</u>"

Rage is quite different from the ease that Jesus promises. And in his great poem, "Fern Hill," the same poet says,

"Oh as I was young and easy in the mercy of his means, Time held me green and dying Though I sang in my chains like the sea."

Dylan Thomas was a raggedy man, who, if rumor is true, drank himself to the death he dreaded. He loved his youth and sang glad song to it, but death always stood waiting, and it did not offer relief to the chains it wrapped around him.

What about Jesus? He said that his yoke was easy yet he went through torture and death. How can this be?

Here is an approach. Maybe labor and burdens are not meant to be erased from our lives, not erased or thrown away, but instead are meant to be pathways to a solid ground far underneath our troubles, into a quiet grounding that is real stillness and rest. What rich earth would that be?

Jesus says it is meekness and humility of heart. In the desert he had already told the devil that the only food he needed was "every word that proceeds from the mouth of God." Maybe the only real goods in life are those rooted in the love that is God and in the meekness and humility that are Jesus' life.

"Watch me," Jesus says. "I am meek, and riding on an ass, on a colt, the foal of an ass (<u>First Reading</u>). Or in other words,

"Watch me on the sad height of Calvary and see. I have let it all go—belongings, beloveds, reputation, everything. One thing remains. In it I find my rest. Make it your life, whatever your sorrow, whatever act of living and dying and being burdened you have, and it will not be heavy. Make it the center of your life and your burden will be light too."

Love.

Love of God and neighbor.

If you can begin to let go into the arms of the Great Love, if you can give your life away instead of raging, you will know rest from your burdens. You will see how death is the ultimate act of giving yourself away, as Jesus did in the midst of his burdens. Meek and humble of heart, he is, not proud and above it all.

Take your troubles and hand them gratefully to the One who can give you rest.


