WHY IS ENROLLMENT DOWN? *Compared to the nationwide 9% decrease, ours is only 4.7%, putting us above the national norm. Holy Trinity School's long term goal is to get more students to keep tuition cost down but not so many that classes sizes go too far up.*

WHY DO WE WANT SMALL CLASS SIZES? *More time for each of your children from our teachers. The reality is that many classrooms have supersized themselves in the public sector to the point that teaching has become more difficult than before. Holy Trinity School's goal is to always be right-sized in order to allow us to give your child a personalized education. At Holy Trinity, your child isn't just a number.*

WHAT'S THE OVERALL GOAL? *We are assessing our current marketing efforts, working on a 5-year plan and leveraging the rebranding work that has come out of the Visioning work. 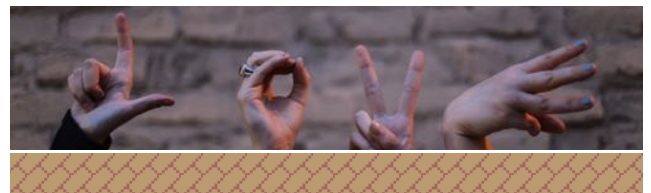
